What is Play Scotland?

Play Scotland is the lead organisation advocating for children's play in Scotland, working at a national and strategic level. We also provide information, undertake research and promote best practice.

Play Scotland works for better play opportunities for all children from 0-18 years in all contexts (at home, in schools and out of school settings, and in communities - streets, parks and public spaces).

What does Play Scotland believe?

Play Scotland believes in the child's right to play and its work is underpinned by the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child Article 31. Our vision is "to make the child's right to play a reality in Scotland".

What does Play Scotland do?

Play Scotland has four strategic areas of work:

Research

Undertaking research projects, for example The Scottish School Grounds Survey

Information

Providing information to members, the public, government, the press and organising events for exchanging and debating play issues

Advocacy

Lobbying and campaigning for play at national level

Demonstration of best practice

Undertaking national demonstration projects
